Primary Mental Health Care services span four identified target populations – children and young people, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people, people in under-served and/or hard to reach areas and people with severe and complex mental illness who are being managed in primary care. PMHC activity focuses on improving access to mental health care and suicide prevention services.

Integrated Team Care activity aims to improve health outcomes for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people with chronic conditions through better access to coordinated, culturally appropriate multidisciplinary care.

Flexible funding is provided to WQPHN to respond to local, identified local health priorities and to commission services to support these priorities.

Drug and Alcohol Treatment Services aims to reduce the impact of substance abuse on individuals, families, carers and communities and include prevention, early intervention and social support services.

After Hours funding aims to increase the efficiency and effectiveness of primary health care for patients with limited access to health services.



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
